

Kid Supervision Guidelines

Those that are College Credit Plus (“CCP”) students and are under 18 years of age need to have the [Tool Lending Policy and Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release](#) signed by a parent or legal guardian before accessing material, tools and machines that could pose risk to the CCP student’s safety.

Those that are not CCP students and are under 18 years of age (“children”) need to have [the Tool Lending Policy and Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Release](#) signed by a parent or legal guardian before accessing materials, tools and machines that could pose risk to the child’s safety. Those children need to be accompanied by a parent, guardian or agent of the parent or guardian throughout the duration of their time in HIVE. Children left in HIVE with no parent, guardian or agent of the parent or guardian cannot use materials, tools or machines in HIVE. Children left in HIVE with no parent, guardian or agent of the parent or guardian cannot participate in HIVE activities that may or may not pose risk to the child’s physical safety.
