Advanced placement for LPNs is available through the ACCESS to Registered Nursing option. An LPN (must hold a current license with no restrictions) who qualifies must have completed the following courses with a 2.5 GPA or higher and must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0; must place into MATH 1550 or higher (based on COMPASS scores) or complete MATH 0950 with a grade of "C" or higher; and have one year of current work experience as an LPN prior to acceptance into the Access to Registered Nursing\* option.

To receive advanced placement, the LPN must complete NURS 1550 - Access to Registered Nursing and NURS 1600 - Transition to the Caring Role of the Nurse with Adults - Level II, with a grade of "C" or better. The LPN will be given credit for the following Nursing Courses:
