OPTION 1: HIGH SCHOOL OPTION

Student should submit this form at time of application to Lakeland Community College

This option is for current high school seniors and high school graduates who apply to the program within **two** years of high school graduation. Students must have the following:

- A. A composite score on the ACT of 21 or higher or a combined SAT score of 1400 or higher
- B. Completion of high school Algebra, Chemistry and Biology with a "C" grade or better
- C. An overall high school GPA of 2.50 or above on a 4.00 scale or equivalent
- D. An Official copy of your High School Transcript at time of Application and again once graduated if still in High School.

PLEASE NOTE: Students using Option 1 must complete HLTH 1210 (Medical Terminology) with a "C" grade or higher prior to enrolling in their first health technology course.

OPTION 2: COLLEGE OPTION

Students pursuing this option should submit this form **AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF PRE-ADMISSION ENTRANCE TEST and COMPLETION OF MANDATORY PRE-REQUISITE COURSES**. The following courses must be completed with program specific GPA requirement. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
