Introduction

The Lakeland Foundation is a public, non-profit corporation established to enhance educational opportunities for Lakeland Community College students. Its purposes are to solicit and receive gifts of money, securities, bequests, and property and to hold and distribute these resources as may be deemed best for the promotion of excellence in programming at Lakeland Community College.

The Lakeland Foundation's goal is to provide scholarships and grants for deserving full- and part-time students of all ages by establishing endowments and scholarship funds. Individuals, families, clubs, corporations, foundations, alumni, academic departments, and other organizations fund these endowments and scholarships. The **Financial Aid Office (FAO)** of Lakeland Community College administers all scholarships, grants and loans. The **FAO** coordinates and administers a comprehensive program of financial assistance for Lakeland student's that includes federal and state programs as well as those provided by The Lakeland Foundation.

In addition, gifts to The Lakeland Foundation support a broad spectrum of programs for which local and state subsidies are not available. These programs are vitally important to the quality of education and services provided by Lakeland Community College.

Because scholarship availability, application deadlines, and award amounts change frequently, this Scholarship Guide should be regarded primarily as a reference guide and not as a binding document.

How to Apply for a Lakeland Foundation Scholarship:

- Applications for all scholarships listed in this guide are available from the Financial Aid Office at Lakeland Community College located in A-1004 (first floor of A Building).
- A single application form is used to determine eligibility for a variety of scholarships, grants and loans that are provided through the generosity of persons, groups and companies.
- Scholarships and grants have specific criteria that a student must meet to further determine eligibility. These may include a written essay on a specific subject or study in a particular career or field, scholastic achievement, financial need or community service.
- Students are responsible for insuring that application materials are complete.

Access Unlimited Scholarship

The Access Unlimited Scholarship was established in 2001 to assist students with disabilities attending Lakeland with financial aid for tuition, books, transportation, childcare and special needs in order to re-take a course.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: **General**
- Must be identified as “active” on the Student with Disabilities roster
- Must be able to demonstrate good effort and responsibility regarding courses taken at Lakeland
- Letter of recommendation from the faculty member of the course proposed to retake
- Scholarship Awards cover tuition, books, fees, and ancillary charges if applicable
- For ancillary fees to be covered, a statement of need must be included with application

Aqua Ohio Endowed Scholarship

The Aqua Ohio Endowed Scholarship Fund was established in 2009 by Aqua Ohio as part of its gift to The Lakeland Foundation’s Next Generation Campaign.

Aqua Ohio, Inc. is Ohio’s largest investor-owned water utility serving nearly 280,000 people in 54 communities. Aqua Ohio is a subsidiary of Aqua America, Inc., a U.S.-based publicly traded water and wastewater utility holding company serving approximately 3 million people.

Aqua Ohio is dedicated to providing quality water service, acting as stewards of the environment and demonstrating leadership through civic involvement in the communities it serves.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Recipients must be full-time or part-time students of Lakeland Community College.
- Recipients must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 after their first semester of enrollment.

Raymond Q. Armington Memorial Endowed Scholarship

The Raymond Q. Armington Memorial Endowed Scholarship was established in memory of Lakeland's long-time friend and former trustee, Raymond Q. Armington, to provide support, encouragement and financial aid to deserving students attending Lakeland Community College. Consideration may be given to individuals having an average academic record but who possess exceptional skills in an area of extended study (i.e., art, writing, computers, etc.)

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: **General**
- GPA: 2.8 (minimum)
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, books/supplies, and childcare expenses
- Selection of recipients by donor and/or donor’s designee
- Students may possess an average academic record, but must possess exceptional skill in an extended area of study

Avery Dennison Scholarship Fund

The Avery Dennison Scholarship Fund was established in 2007 by Avery Dennison to assist students attending Lakeland Community College. Preference is given to students enrolled in **Graphic Design** and **Business** related Programs.

Eligibility Criteria:

- full-time or part-time student(s) at Lakeland Community College
- maintain a minimum accumulative GPA of 2.5 after the first semester of enrollment
- able to demonstrate a need for financial assistance as determined by the Financial Aid office of Lakeland Community College

C. R. Bard Endowment Scholarship

The C.R. Bard Scholarship was established through the generosity of the Bard Endoscopic Technologies of Mentor, Ohio.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full time (12 or more credit hours per semester)
- Field of Study: **Engineering Technologies** or **Business program** at LCC
- GPA: 2.5
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application
- Scholarship awards cover tuition and fees
- Priority given to previous employees of the Bard Endoscopic Technologies

Margaret “Mickey” Beall Memorial Endowed Scholarship

The Margaret “Mickey” Beall Memorial Endowed Scholarship was established by friends and family of Mickey Beall led by Kelly Garbo. Margaret "Mickey" Beall took the Oath of Office with the Kirtland Police Department on June 8th, 1979. Mickey was one of the first female police officers in Lake County and the first for the Kirtland Police Department. During her 24 years in office, Mickey became deeply involved in the community. She spent countless hours talking to citizens and helping elderly people with household tasks. Each Christmas, she baked breads and delivered them to senior citizens in the community and each summer for 28 years she volunteered her time teaching children about safety at Safety Town. Mickey was a pioneer in community policing decades before it was recognized as a cornerstone of police work. Mickey passed away from cancer on March 3rd, 2007, but the impact she made on the city of Kirtland will be remembered for years to come.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Recipients must be full-time or part-time students of Lakeland Community College.
- Recipients must major in or plan to major in Law Enforcement, Fire Science, Emergency Medical or the Lakeland Police Academy.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 after their first semester of enrollment.

Karl Bernal Scholarship

This agreement establishes the Karl Bernal Scholarship Fund of the Lakeland Foundation. This scholarship is in honor of Karl Bernal who devoted most of his life to helping others. He wanted all foundations to help all needy students of all ages. Race or gender was never to be a consideration. He had the NAACP and various other organizations give scholarships to all. Donations came from many Lake County businesses. The Red Cross, NAACP, Society for the Blind, Kiwanis, Salvation Army, Blue Coats, Lake County Mental Health, and St. James Episcopal Church are just a few of the organizations to which he devoted his time.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part-time
- Field of study: **General**
- GPA: 2.0 minimum cumulative after first semester of enrollment.
- Scholarship Awards may be made to cover the cost of tuition, books or fees.

Michael Bernal Scholarship

This agreement establishes the Michael Bernal Scholarship Fund of the Lakeland Foundation in November 2009. The donor's intention is 1) to encourage Lakeland Community College students to begin and continue their education; 2) to encourage students who have clear career goals; 3) to encourage students to move into internships or jobs while they are completing their college careers and 4) to encourage students to move as quickly as possible into full-time employment on completion of their college careers.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Recipients must be full-time or part-time students of Lakeland Community College.
- Recipients must meet and comply with all admission requirements of Lakeland Community College and must be enrolled in the college during the term in which the award applies.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 after their first semester of enrollment.

Jeffrey A. Berzin Memorial Endowed Scholarship

The Jeffrey A. Berzin Memorial Endowed Scholarship was established by Deborah (Berzin) Barton in memory of her late husband, Jeffrey, to provide support and encouragement for students majoring in radiologic technology at Lakeland Community College.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part-time
- Field of Study: **Radiologic Technology**
- GPA: 3.0 (minimum)
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, and books/supplies

Black Professionals Association Scholarship

The Black Professionals Association Scholarship was established through the generosity of The Black Professionals Association Charitable Foundation to provide financial assistance for African American students attending Lakeland Community College. Preference will be given to students from the Greater Cleveland area.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: General
- GPA: 2.0 (minimum)
- Restricted to African American students
- Preference given to students from the Greater Cleveland area
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, and books/supplies

Bricklayers and Allied Craft Workers Local 16 & Northeast Ohio Contractors Association Endowed Scholarship

The Bricklayers Local 16 & Northern Ohio Contractors Association Scholarship was established through the generosity of Bricklayers Local 16 and the Northern Ohio Contractors Association to assist deserving students enrolled in one of Lakeland's certificate or degree programs.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field(s) of Study: **General**
- GPA: 2.5 (minimum--after first semester of enrollment)
- Primary consideration will be given to a member, spouse, child or grandchild of a Bricklayers Local 16 member.
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany application
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, and books
- Selection of recipients made by Scholarship Committee
- Scholarship finalists may be personally interviewed by Scholarship Committee

Esther K. Cardinal Endowed Scholarship

The Esther K. Cardinal Endowed Scholarship was established by the Cardinal family in memory of Dr. Esther K. Cardinal, a former associate professor of English at Lakeland Community College, to provide financial assistance to students majoring in the field of English.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: **General/English**
- GPA: 3.0 (minimum)
- Selection of recipients made by donor

Bob Coates Geography Scholarship

The Bob Coates Geography Scholarship was established in 2002 with an initial gift of \$1,000 from John Niedzialek in honor of Professor Robert Coates. Professor Coates taught geography at Lakeland for 31 years. Professor Coates passed away in September of 2000.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: **General**
- Must be enrolled in one of the geography courses beyond GEOG 1500 (i.e. GEOG 2000, GEOG 2500, or GEOG 2600).
- Scholarship awards are focused on the provision of tuition and books

Homer A. Cole Scholarship

The Homer A. Cole Scholarship was established through the Homer A. Cole Trust to provide scholarship assistance for students attending Lakeland Community College who previously attended high school while living in the city of Willowick.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: **General**
- GPA: 2.5 (minimum)
- Restricted to students who are attending or who have attended high school while residents of the city of Willowick, Lake County, Ohio
- Scholastic ability and financial need shall be given equal weight in determining scholarship recipients

Each award will be given until the student has completed his/her course of study at Lakeland, as long as a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is maintained.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: **General**
- GPA: 3.0 (minimum)
- Restricted to residents of either Lake or Geauga County
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application
- Scholarship awards are given to students to complete their course of study at Lakeland Community College as long as the minimum 3.0 GPA is maintained
- Scholarship awards cover tuition and fees

College Tech Prep Consortium 'Jack Steinicke' Scholarship

The College Tech Prep Consortium 'Jack Steinicke' Scholarship was established through the Tech Prep Consortium at Lakeland Community College and is open to any Lakeland Tech Prep Consortium student who has completed the two-year high school Tech Prep program and is continuing the same Tech Prep Associate Degree cluster at Lakeland Community College.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time (minimum 6 credit hours per semester)
- Field(s) of Study: **All Associate Degree programs related to the student's high school Tech Prep program**
- GPA: 2.5 (minimum)
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, and books/supplies
- Scholarship applications are available from high school Tech Prep teachers, the Lakeland Tech Prep office, or Lakeland's Financial Aid office
- Scholarship applications must include personal recommendations from two (home) high school faculty members and one Tech Prep instructor
- Selection of recipients made by Tech Prep Consortium scholarship committee

Winn Patrick Cunningham Endowed Memorial Scholarship

The Winn Patrick Cunningham Memorial Endowment Fund was established in 1995 to provide financial assistance to a student who plays baseball or softball while attending Lakeland Community College. This scholarship is a tribute to the memory of Winn Patrick Cunningham who passed away at the age of 16 in August 1995.

Eligibility Criteria:

Malcolm Daisley Endowed Scholarship

- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, and books/supplies

Stephanie Dronbrook Women's Center Endowment Fund

The Lakeland Women's Center Endowment Fund was established in 2003 and renamed in January 2008 in memory of Stephanie Dornbrook to promote the mission of The Women's Center at Lakeland Community College. This fund is established to encourage and support women in their quest for quality education, economic opportunity and community involvement.

Eligibility Criteria:

- The Endowment Committee of The Women's Center at Lakeland Community College determines qualified individuals and programs.

Ralph R. Doty Endowed Scholarship

The Ralph R. Doty Endowed Scholarship was established to honor Dr. Ralph R. Doty for his vision and accomplishments as President of Lakeland Community College from August 1988 through July 2001, his dedication to educational advancement and excellence, and for his outstanding leadership within the community.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment Status: Full or part time (minimum 6 credit hours per semester)
- Field(s) of Study: **General**
- GPA: 2.5 (minimum)
- Preference will be given to adult students entering college after being out of high school for 5 years or more, with the intent to remain in the community after receiving their degree
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application
- Scholarship awards cover tuition and fees

Emerald Society Shannon McBride Police Academy Scholarship Fund

This scholarship was established in the memory of Shannon L. McBride to provide scholarship assistance to a student enrolled in Lakeland's Police academy and a student of Irish decent.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment Status: Student must be enrolled in **Lakeland's Police Academy**
- \$500 is annually awarded to a student

Exchange Club of Western Lake County

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment Status: Full-time
- Students must meet and comply with all admission requirements at Lakeland Community College and are enrolled in **any degree program**.

- those who meet and comply with all admission requirements at Lakeland Community College and are enrolled in the **business, accounting or finance certificate or degree** program.
- maintain a minimum accumulative GPA of 2.5 after the first semester of enrollment able to demonstrate a need for financial assistance

Olga Freitag Endowed Alumni Scholarship

The Olga Freitag Endowed Alumni Scholarship was established in memory of Olga Freitag under whose leadership the Lakeland Alumni Association was formed. The scholarship is actively supported by Lakeland's alumni association.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Academic standing and/or financial need may be used as criteria for selection
- The scholarship applicant must sign a release granting the College the right to publish the recipient's name and/or photograph upon the awarding of the scholarship
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, books/supplies, and/or child care expenses

Hildred M. Gehring Memorial Nursing Scholarship

The Hildred M. Gehring Memorial Nursing Scholarship was established by Mr. & Mrs. Richard H. Gehring in memory of his mother who was a nurse. The purpose of the scholarship fund is to enhance nursing education at Lakeland Community College.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time (minimum 8 credit hours per semester)
- Field of Study: **Nursing**
- GPA: 2.5 (minimum)
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, books/supplies
- Selection of recipients by Lakeland's Director of Nursing

Clifton Gilbert Memorial Photography Scholarship

The Clifton Gilbert Memorial Photography Scholarship was established in January 2007 by Joanne and Brian Jackson as a tribute - in memory of their brother "Jimmy" Clifton Gilbert who died January 26, 2007.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Full-time or part-time students enrolled in **Photography classes** at Lakeland Community College
- Maintain a minimum accumulative GPA of 2.5 after the first semester of enrollment.
- Able to demonstrate the need for financial assistance as determined by the Financial Aid Office of Lakeland Community College.

Golf Undesignated Fund

The Golf Fund was established to assist student athletes and the golf program at Lakeland Community College.

Eligibility Criteria:

- A full-time student attending Lakeland Community College who is an active **student athlete in the golf program.**
- GPA: 2.0 (minimum)
- Students enrolled in any of Lakeland's certificate or degree programs.
- Scholarship award can be used for tuition, fees, and books

Government & Public Service Technologies Scholarship

This scholarship was established through an agreement between the Lake County Board of County Commissioners and Lakeland Community College and is funded by the leasing of tower space for radio communications and cell phone equipment. Eligible scholarship candidates must be enrolled in a certificate or degree program leading to a career in government or public service.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time (minimum 6 credit hours per semester)
- Field(s) of Study: **Government or public service technologies, including: Corrections, Criminal Justice, Early Childhood Education, Fire Science Technology, Human Services, Law Enforcement, Public Service, Emergency Management Planning and Administration, or Basic Police Academy**
- GPA: 2.8 (minimum)
- Restricted to residents of Lake County, Ohio

- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, and books
- Scholarship awards will be presented by the Lake County Board of County Commissioners at one of their meetings in September of each year

Jerry Gryzmala Vietnam Veterans Scholarship

The Jerry Gryzmala Vietnam Veterans Scholarship was established in memory of Jerry Gryzmala, former Post Commander of the Veterans of Vietnam War, Post OH-07, Eastlake, Ohio, for deserving students who served in the Armed Forces of the United States between August 5, 1964 and May 7, 1975 (the Vietnam Era) or for a child or grandchild of a Vietnam Era Veteran.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time (minimum 6 credit hours per semester)
- Field of Study: **General**
- GPA: 2.5 (minimum)
- Restricted to students who have served in the Armed Forces of the United States between August 5, 1964 and May 7, 1975 (the Vietnam Era) or is the child or grandchild of a Vietnam Era Veteran
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, and books/supplies
- Selection of recipients made by the Vietnam Veterans, Post OH-07 Scholarship Committee
- Scholarship awards shall be awarded at a meeting of the Veterans of the Vietnam War, Post OH-07

GTS Scholarship

This scholarship was established for to financially assist students participating in the soccer program at Lakeland Community College.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time (minimum 8 credit hours per semester)
- Field of Study: **General**
- Students must be participants of the Lakeland Community College Soccer Team
- Awards may be based on financial need and/or merit and athletic ability
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees and educational expenses

Cpl. Joshua S. Harmon Scholarship

The Cpl. Joshua S. Harmon Scholarship was established in May of 2009 in memory of Cpl. Joshua S. Harmon. Joshua Harmon was born in Euclid on November 25, 1986; he died in Iraq on August 22, 2007. Joshua was a U.S Army Veteran Specialist E/4, assigned to the 25th Light Infantry Division, 35th Infantry Regiment, 2nd Battalion. He served as combat medic attached to the Scouts Sniper Platoon and received the Army Medal of Commendation of Valor and the Combat Medical Badge. When returning from a mission, Joshua lost his life when the UH-60 Black Hawk helicopter that was transporting him crashed in Multaka outside of Kirkuk. Thirteen fellow soldiers also lost their lives in the crash.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Recipients must be full-time or part-time students at Lakeland Community College.
- Recipients must major in any of the following areas: **Music, Emergency Medical/Paramedic, Fire Science or Criminal Justice**. Priority will be given to students in music programs.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 after their first semester of enrollment.

Hawk Family/Mentor Woman's Club Scholarship

The Hawk Family/Mentor Woman's Club Scholarship was previously administered by the Mentor Woman's Club. This agreement calls for the Mentor Woman's Club to provide remaining and possible future dollars to the Hawk Family/Mentor Woman's Club Scholarship Fund of The Lakeland Foundation to annually award one or more scholarships to Lakeland Community College students who reside in or attended high school in Mentor and intend to pursue careers in health-related areas.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Recipients must be full-time or part-time students of Lakeland Community College.
- Recipients must have graduated from any high school – public or private – located in Mentor, Ohio or must be a current resident of Mentor, Ohio.
- Recipients must be majoring in or demonstrate a strong interest in pursuing a health-related career.
- Recipients must have completed the equivalent of one year of college and must be eligible to begin a second academic year.
- Recipients must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 after their initial year of enrollment.

Heavenly Ham Endowed Scholarship

The Heavenly Ham Scholarship was established in 2001 to provide financial assistance for the pursuit of an education at Lakeland Community College to students who have at one point in their lives been in the custody of Lake County Department of Job and Family Services (foster care or residential services).

- Applicant must have at one point in their lives been in the custody of Lake County Department of Job and Family Services (foster care or residential services)
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application
- Scholarship focused on provision of tuition, fees and books

Hispanic General Scholarship Fund

This scholarship was established in 2004 to remove financial barriers and provide assistance for Hispanic students attending Lakeland Community College. The fund provides for tuition, fees, books, supplies and other expenses. Scholarship recipients are eligible if they attend full time or part time, and are traditional or non- traditional students. Classes can include: remedial courses, ESL courses – credit and non- credit classes.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part-time student
- Field of Study: **General**
- Student must meet and comply with all admission requirements at Lakeland Community College and be enrolled in –a certificate or degree program, and/or non-credit or community education program.
- GPA: 2.0 (minimum) accumulative after first semester of enrollment
- Student must demonstrate a need for financial assistance
- Scholarship award covers tuition, fees, books, supplies, and other expenses

Arthur S. Holden, Jr. Endowed Scholarship

The Arthur S. Holden, Jr. Endowed Scholarship was established in honor of Arthur S. Holden, Jr., founder and first chairman of the board of trustees of Lakeland Community College, to assist deserving students attending Lakeland Community College. Consideration will be given to a student's good moral character, integrity, leadership potential, and prior and current involvement in extracurricular activities and/or family responsibilities. No past conviction record or indication of use of narcotics.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time (minimum 6 credit hours per semester)
- Field of Study: **General**
- GPA: 2.8 (minimum)
- Consideration will be given to a student's good moral character, integrity, leadership potential, and prior and current involvement in extracurricular activities and/or family responsibilities
- No past conviction record or indication of use of narcotics
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, book/supplies, and child care

Home Savings Business Scholarship

The Home Savings Business Scholarship was established in April 2006 to assist outstanding students. Home Savings serves communities where Home savings has an established office. Home Savings encourages and develops relationships with local colleges and considers education a priority investment in the future.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Scholarship applicants must complete a Professional Secretaries International Scholarship Application Form
- Representatives of the North Coast Chapter of International Association of Administrative Professionals will select scholarship candidates
- Scholarship awards will be presented to recipients at a meeting of the North Coast Chapter of International Association of Administrative Professionals
- Scholarship awards cover tuition and fees

Eligibility Criteria:

Willis P. Kern Memorial Scholarship

The Willis P. Kern Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Willis P. Kern, a former president of the college, to provide financial assistance for a student enrolled in Lakeland Community College majoring in the field of education.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment status: Full or part time
- Field of Study: **Education**
- Must demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, books, and supplies

Key Bank Hispanic Internship Scholarship

Key Bank is offering financial scholarship of \$1,500 each for two Lakeland Community College students that are enrolled in any of the business majors that Lakeland Community College offers. - Recipients are not required to have any minimum grade point average.
- Although a FAFSA is not required to be on file, financial need will be a part of the overall selection and interview process.

Kirtland Kiwanis Endowment Scholarship Fund

This scholarship was created in December 2005, by the Kirtland Kiwanis, to be held in perpetuity, in The Lakeland Foundation at Lakeland Community College. The scholarship is offered to a Lakeland student who resides within the Kirtland Schools District.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Student must reside within the Kirtland Schools District
- Scholarship awards may be used for tuition, books, and fees

Tim Kling Memorial Chemistry Scholarship Endowment

The Tim Kling Memorial Chemistry Scholarship was established as a lasting tribute to Tim Kling a chemistry faculty member. This scholarship is for students entering their second year of Chemistry.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Scholarship recipient will be selected by the Chemistry Department Faculty

Lake County AFL-CIO John Osters Memorial Scholarship

The Lake County AFL-CIO John Osters Memorial Scholarship is made available through the generosity of the members of the Lake County AFL-CIO in memory of John Osters, former president of the AFL-CIO Central Labor Council. - Application must be accompanied by a brief, typed 250-word essay discussing the applicant reason for attending Lakeland, their career or job aspirations, topic of labor unions/membership—sample titles would include: “What labor union membership means to me/my family”, or “The impact of unions on working conditions”, and the reasons for their need for a scholarship—tuition assistance.
- Qualified applicants should be a member or immediate/extended relative of a member in a labor union.
- Proof of eligibility must be provided by furnishing a copy of a membership card in a labor union or other appropriate documentation
- Scholarship awards cover tuition and fees
- Selection of recipients by Lake County AFL-CIO Scholarship Committee
- Scholarship recipients will be requested to attend the annual AFL-CIO fundraiser

Lake County Association of Chiefs of Police Scholarship

Lake Hospital System Nursing Scholarship

The Lake Hospital System Nursing Scholarship was established in January 2002, to provide a full scholarship for a nursing student attending Lakeland Community College. This Scholarship is intended for full-time students enrolled in the Nursing program at Lakeland Community College. This scholarship is granted with the understanding that, upon graduation from Lakeland Community College, the recipient agrees to a work commitment of two (2) years at Lake Hospital System. Specifics on this work commitment will be determined directly by Lake Hospital System and the scholarship recipient.

Eligibility Criteria:

- GPA: 3.0 (minimum)
- Students must have successfully completed 1st semester of Nursing courses
- Must commit to work commitment at Lake Hospital System upon graduation
- Scholarship applicants must submit two (2) letters of recommendation. One letter shall be from a current professor, the other shall be from an outside source
- Scholarship awards cover tuition, fees, books, equipment, required tests and uniforms
- Recipients chosen by the Lake Hospital System's Nursing Director

Lake Hospital System Respiratory Scholarship

The Lake Hospital System Respiratory Therapy Scholarship was established in January 2002, to provide a full scholarship for a respiratory therapy student attending Lakeland Community College. This Scholarship is intended for full-time students enrolled in the Respiratory Therapy program at Lakeland Community College. This scholarship is granted with the understanding that, upon graduation from Lakeland Community College, the recipient agrees to a work commitment of two (2) years at Lake Hospital System. Specifics on this work commitment will be determined directly by Lake Hospital System and the scholarship recipient.

Eligibility Criteria:

- GPA: 2.5 (minimum)
- Recipient shall receive no more than \$500.00 per semester
- Scholarship awards will cover tuition, fees, and books/supplies
- Must be able to demonstrate need for financial assistance
- A completed FAFSA form must accompany scholarship application

The Lakeland Foundation Board of Directors Immediate Needs Program

The Lakeland Foundation established this scholarship fund to assist students attending Lakeland Community College who have experienced an unforeseen financial hardship resulting in an immediate and special need for assistance.

Eligibility Criteria:

The Sharon L. LoPresti Memorial Scholarship was established by James M. LoPresti in memory of his wife Sharon who was a 1975 graduate of the Lakeland Community College Dental Hygiene program.

Eligibility Criteria:

Lubrizol Foundation Scholarship

Chambers Detachment of Lake County of the Marine Corps League to assist deserving students enrolled in a program leading to an associate degree or certificate program at Lakeland Community College or a program leading to a four-year academic degree. Applicants must be members in good standing of the Colonel Justice M. Chambers Detachment of Lake County.

Eligibility Criteria:

Men's Resource Center Scholarship

- Recipients chosen by the Men's Center director

Mentor Recycling Environmental Management Project Endowed Scholarship

The Mentor Recycling and Environmental Management Project Endowed Scholarship was established by the Mentor Recycling Project, Inc. to assist students enrolled in the

environmental management program at Lakeland Community College.

Andy Nowacki Memorial Scholarship Endowment

This scholarship was created in March 2005, as a tribute to the memory of Andy Nowacki, US Marine Lance Cpl. and Grand River Police Officer who heroically gave his life for his country while protecting a convoy south of Baghdad, Iraq. This scholarship will be held in perpetuity, by The Lakeland Foundation of Lakeland Community College, located in Lake County - where Andy lived and worked. This scholarship will be offered to students who exemplify Andy's compassion and service to his nation and community. A person, who has a passion for serving in law enforcement, and who, like Andy, possesses a positive attitude towards achieving successes in all his endeavors.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Enrollment Status: Full-time or part-time (6 or more credit hours)
- Students who meet and comply with all admission requirements at Lakeland Community College and are enrolled in **public service programs such as: Law Enforcement, Police Academy, Criminal Justice, Fire Science, Emergency Medical Technology – (EMT) paramedic's certificates/programs.**
- GPA: 2.5 (minimum)
- Determination of need is flexible per the donor's request. One of the objectives of this scholarship is to minimize restrictions to ensure that the student does not drop out of the program due to financial difficulty.

Ohio Word Processing Society Endowed Scholarship

George and Agnes Roberts First Generation Hispanic Scholarship Fund

Gayle A. Sanford Memorial Scholarship

The Gayle A. Sanford Memorial Scholarship was established by Bill Sanford, former president & CEO of STERIS Corporation, in memory of his uncle, Gayle Sanford, to assist full-time student athletes who are enrolled in one of Lakeland's health, engineering, or business technologies certificate or degree programs. Eligibility Criteria:

S.I.F.E. Scholarship Fund

- A resident of Lake County is the preferred candidate, but students from other counties may apply providing that they meet all eligibility criteria

Stam, Inc. Scholarship

The endowment funds learning opportunities that help to foster the growth of emerging leaders at Lakeland Community College. The endowment also reduces financial barriers to student leaders who take an active role in positively impacting the Lakeland college community.

Talent Grants

Donald J. Taverner Memorial Endowment Scholarship
