Lakeland Community College Mandatory Student Health Requirements **Dental Hygiene**

The following mandatory student health requirements must be met prior to enrollment in the Health Technology programs. Clinical facilities require documentation of health requirements prior to participation in clinical experiences. Please schedule an appointment with your health care provider now. It is important for you to be aware that the process for Hepatitis B vaccinations and titers takes approximately 8 months to complete. Your enrollment in the **Dental Hygiene** program will be delayed if these requirements are not met. All of the following requirements must be documented on Lakeland's Student Health Record Form. Students entering a Health Technology program must submit a completed Student Health Record Form 2 months prior to the start of class. Submit forms to:

Physical examination: A physical examination by a primary health care provider is required. This examination may be completed within one year prior to enrollment in the program.

Tuberculin Test (PPD) -A two step TB test **or** a QuantiFERON gold blood test is required 3 months prior to starting clinicals. Please note: Mantoux test results can not be self-read, but must be read by a health official within 48-72 hours. An official document listing date of administration and date of results must be submitted to the Health Services Department, in S 011, for every Mantoux test completed and a copy of the lab results for the blood test. Average cost of the 2step TB is \$12 and the blood test is \$89, the cost will vary by provider.

QuantiFERON gold blood test - Required within six months prior to starting clinicals for students who are known **Positive reactors**.

Immunizations: The following immunizations **and/or** titers are required. If your titer is negative then you **must** receive a booster.

Hepatitis B: A series of three injections **and** a titer. It will take 8 months to complete the entire process. If the titer is negative, additional vaccinations are required.

Td or Tdap : every 10 years to reactivate immunity.

Mumps: Vaccination date, more recent than 1982, or a positive antibody titer.

Rubella: Vaccination date, more recent than 1982, or a positive antibody titer.

Rubeola: Vaccination date, more recent than 1982, or a positive antibody titer.

Varicella: Vaccination date, 2 doses, or a positive antibody titer.

Do not write "had disease" for any of the above.

Recommended, but not required: Polio: A positive antibody titer.

Please submit your completed physical forms prior to starting class in the Fall. The TB test should be done in July prior to the start of class.
