Becoming a Registered Nurse

Registered nurses play a critical role in providing quality patient care.

Nurses:

- » Provide and coordinate patient care
- » Collect, interpret, analyze and draw conclusions about clients/patients in a variety of care settings
- » Administer treatments and medications
- » Assist clients in coping with illness
- » Educate clients, their families and the community on strategies to promote and optimize health
- » Nurses may choose areas of specialty such as:
 - by population, infants, children, adolescents, adults, older adults and vulnerable populations
 - by work setting or type of care provided such as ambulatory, critical care, medical-surgical or psychiatric.
 - a particular body system, disease or condition, such as cardiac, dermatology, gynecology or urology

How long does it take to complete this program and be job-ready?

- » 66 credits approximately 2 years
- » Program starts fall and spring semesters of each year.



Credential

Lakeland's program graduates are eligible to take the national exam to become a registered nurse known, as a NCLEX-RN.
