Youngstown State University's (YSU) Bachelor of Science in Applied Science (B.S.A.S.) in criminal justice is a bachelor's degree completion program for students who have completed an associate degree in criminal justice. YSU provides 30 semester hours of Criminal Justice courses taught by YSU professors through Lakeland's Holden University Center. Students pay YSU tuition and fees for these 30 hours. All other necessary coursework, (general education requirements, courses for the required Associate of Applied Science degree (A.A.S.), etc.) can be taken at Lakeland at Lakeland tuition costs. Once students have completed all Lakeland courses toward their A.A.S., they may apply for admission to YSU as a transfer student to begin the B.S.A.S.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Partnership students must meet YSU admission standards, including a 2.0 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Prospective partnership students should contact a program representative to request preliminary evaluation prior to the application or registration process.

PARALLEL LAKELAND PROGRAMS:

An A.A.S. in corrections or law enforcement is required for the B.S.A.S. A YSU advisor will work with students to determine what additional Lakeland courses may be required.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

The B.S.A.S. in criminal justice requires a *minimum* of 120 credit hours, including approximately 60 credit hours in criminal justice coursework.
