The Organizational Leadership Partnership program allows students to earn a Bachelor of Arts degree without leaving the campus of Lakeland Community College by taking classes through the Holden University Center. Cleveland State classes are taught via Distance Learning (IVDL) by CSU faculty and instructors. The Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership is a multidisciplinary program of study for students interested in leadership theory and practice. The program prepares students to assume leadership roles in organizational settings in the public, private and nonprofit sectors. Students may complete some major requirements through the Assessment and Accreditation for Prior Learning Credit for Life Experience program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Partnership students must meet the Cleveland State admission standards for transfer students, including a 2.0 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) from Lakeland Community College and any additional colleges or universities attended. Partnership students must complete the undergraduate admissions application and partnership application supplement form.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Prospective partnership students are encouraged to contact the CSU partnership office for a preliminary evaluation of their course credits. PARALLEL LAKELAND PROGRAMS:

An Associate of Arts or Applied Business degree will assist students in completing corresponding coursework needed for the Bachelor of Arts in Organizational Leadership including General Education requirements, lower-division major requirements, and elective courses. A completed Associates degree is not required, but highly encouraged.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

The BA in Organizational Leadership requires a minimum of 120 total credit hours. A minimum of 30 credit hours must be CSU coursework.

Financial Aid is available to eligible students who have completed their FAFSA. Financial Aid can only be awarded by one school at a time.
