The Hiram College Bachelor of Arts in Accounting and Financial Management provides a quality education in the liberal arts tradition proven to be essential for future success. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Partnership students must have accumulated a minimum of 30 transfer credit hours
- A 2.5 cumulative GPA from Lakeland is required for admission
- No ACT/SAT Score Required
- Application is Required
- Admission decision in less than 7 business days

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Prospective students should schedule an appointment to meet with a Hiram admission counselor to learn how their credits will transfer.

A Hiram representative holds office hours at the Holden Center on a weekly basis. It's never too early to meet with an advisor.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR:

Each academic semester includes two eight-week terms. Our unique schedule allows students to enroll in 14-16 credit hours per semester, while only taking two courses at a time.

TEXTBOOK PURCHASE:

Hiram partnership students purchase textbooks through the Hiram College website and can have them shipped directly to their home.

DELIVERY MODE:

- All classes place in one of two formats: Blended or Fully Online
- Blended classes are half online and half in-person, they meet every other week for 4 hours at **one** of the following times:
 - Thursdays 6pm-10pm
 - Fridays 6pm-10pm
 - Saturdays 8am-12pm
 - Saturdays 2pm-6pm

All blended classes meet at
Lakeland's Holden University Center.

PARALLEL LAKELAND PROGRAMS:

Lakeland's Associate of Applied Business degree in Accounting will prepare students for Hiram College coursework.

Courses taken at Lakeland may be applied to major requirements, general education requirements and elective coursework.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

The Bachelor of Arts in Accounting requires a minimum of 120 credit hours, 75 of which can be taken at Lakeland.
