ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Partnership students must meet the Cleveland State University admission standards for transfer students, including a 2.0 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) from Lakeland Community College and any additional colleges or universities attended. Partnership students must complete the undergraduate admissions application and partnership application supplement form.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Prospective partnership students are encouraged to contact the CSU partnership office for a preliminary evaluation of their course credits. TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:
