Youngstown State University's (YSU) Bachelor of Science in Applied Science (B.S.A.S.) in allied health is a bachelor's degree completion program for students who have completed an Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) or equivalent degree in a health-related field. The primary objective of the program is to provide graduates of healthcare programs the opportunity to gain the added expertise needed to expand their professional roles in the healthcare field. YSU will provide 30 semester hours of allied health classes taught by YSU professors online. Students pay YSU tuition and fees for these 30 hours. All other necessary coursework (general education and upper division courses, courses for the required A.A.S. and an optional minor) can be taken at Lakeland at Lakeland tuition costs.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Partnership students must meet YSU admission standards, including a 2.0 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA).

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Prospective partnership students should contact a program representative to request preliminary evaluation prior to the application or registration process.

PARALLEL LAKELAND PROGRAMS:

An associate degree in a health profession is required for the B.S.A.S. A YSU advisor will work with students to determine what additional Lakeland courses may be required.

TOTAL HOURS NEEDED:

The B.S.A.S. in allied health requires a *minimum* of 120 credit hours, including 30 credit hours in allied health coursework.
