

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Grants to Students

Acknowledgement

Lakeland Community College has signed and returned to the Department of Education (ED) the Certification and Agreement and assured that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES), the Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and American Rescue Plan (ARP) to provide emergency grants to students.

Total Funds

Lakeland Community College has received \$8,955,946 in HEERF emergency grant funds for students.

Total Distribution

From July 1 through September 30, 2021, Lakeland awarded \$2,229,655 in HEERF grant funds to students.

Number of Students Who Have Received ARP Funds

From July 1 through September 30, 2021, 2,097 students have been awarded HEERF grant funds.

Number of Students Who Were Eligible to Receive HEERF Emergency Grant

From July 1 through September 30, 2021, 4,552 students were eligible to apply for HEERF grant funds.

Determination of Distribution

All enrolled students for summer and/or fall 2021 who have an eligible expense due to the COVID-19 pandemic including, but not limited to, items related to their cost of attendance, such as tuition and fees, books, food, technology, transportation, medical and mental health care and child care may apply for a maximum of \$1500 in HEERF funding.

Instructions

Students could apply by submitting the HEERF application which is located on the Coronavirus Response & Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (<u>CRRSAA</u>) and the American Rescue Plan (<u>ARP</u>) webpages.
