Eligibility - All junior high or senior high musicians who have completed the seventh grade. **Students must be recommended by their music directors.**

Cost - **Commuter Camp Only** - \$349. Includes a \$5 daily lunch voucher.

Financial Aid - Students may apply for scholarship assistance on the basis of musical proficiency and/or need. A special application is required for this purpose and is available upon request. All scholarships are contingent upon funds available. (Deadline: May 13, 2011.)

Auditions - All students will be auditioned on the first day of camp for placement. **Students should have a short piece of music prepared for this purpose.**
