Local Scholarships

Charles D. Whitmer WSI Scholarship: Applicant must be U.S. citizen or legal resident; must reside in Cuyahoga, Lorain, Lake, or Geauga counties; be enrolled (or plan to enroll) full time in an accredited four-year college or university, or are enrolled in an ROTC or similar program; must work, save, and pay for a portion of their educational expenses, and show self-motivation, initiative, good work ethic, and entrepreneurial spirit. www.clevelandfoundation.com/scholarships

Cleveland Clinic Robert D. Kruse Memorial Scholarship Fund for Allied Health Professionals: Students may apply for funding for their final year of study. Scholarships may be awarded based on the workforce need of the Cleveland Clinic. http://my.clevelandclinic.org/allied_health/default.aspx

College Now Greater Cleveland Adult Learner Scholarship: College Now provides scholarship opportunities to adult students age 19 and above who have taken off one year or more after high school. Eligible adult learners must be pursuing a first bachelor's degree, an associate's degree or a non-degree certificate or license in a vocational or technical program. Harriet B. Storrs Fund Grant for Adult Learners: Awards of up to \$1,500 for U. S. citizens living in Painesville City or Township who have had at least one year of interruption in their education. 2.5 GPA required. Junior Women's Club of Mentor Adult Learner Scholarship: Applicant must be a female, U.S. citizen, 25 years or older as of June 1, and a resident of Lake

County; must be enrolled at least half-time, and if already enrolled, must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA. www.leaf-ohio.org

Lake County Medical Alliance Scholarship: Applicant must be a resident of Lake County, pursuing an undergraduate degree in a health-related field; a minimum 3.0 GPA is required and must be maintained to renew this scholarship. www.lcms.net

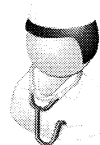
Ohio Housing Authority Conference Scholarship: Applicant must be a resident of assisted housing or been subsidized in private market housing through the Section 8 voucher program; minimum 3.0 GPA or passing score of 60 on the G.E.D. required. www.ohac.com/scholarship.html

Ohio Nurses Foundation; Students Returning to School: Several scholarship programs for nursing students in various levels of study. Also provide research grants to nurses and nurses who want to teach nursing. www.ohnurses.org

P.E.O. Program for Continuing Education: Applicant must be a female, U.S. or Canadian citizen who has had at least 24 consecutive months as a non-student sometime during her adult life, and is within 24 consecutive months of completing her educational goal. Contact: Gail Fortunato, (440) 352-7517

Western Reserve Junior Service League Adult Scholarship: Applicant must be a female, U.S. citizen, 25 years or older as of June 1, and a resident of Lake, Geauga, or Ashtabula Counties; must be enrolled at least half time, working toward an associate's or first bachelor's degree. If currently enrolled, a minimum 3.0 GPA is required. www.leaf-ohio.org

Junior League of Cleveland: Applicant must be a non-traditional student, a woman not going directly to a four-year college immediately after high school graduation. Therefore, we will NOT consider applications from women going directly from high school to a four-year college. Up to \$5,000 may be used in the current academic year for tuition, fees, books, supplies, transportation, or child care while the recipient attends an accredited training or educational program. www.jlcleveland.org

State & National Scholarships

AARP Foundation Women's Scholarship Program: Applicants must be women, ages 40+, seeking new job skills, training, and educational opportunities to support themselves and their families. Based on financial need. Fall deadline. www.aarpfoundationwlc.org

AAUW Career Development Grant: Applicants must be female, U. S. citizens, who hold bachelor's degrees and who are planning to advance their careers, change careers, or re-enter the workforce. www.aauw.org/education

Jeanette Rankin Foundation Grants: Applicants must be female, U.S. citizens, ages 35+ as of March 1, pursuing a technical/vocational education, associate's or first bachelor's degree. Based on financial need. www.rankinfoundation.org

Minority Nurse Scholarship Program: Applicant must be a racial or ethnic minority, a U.S. citizen or permanent resident, and be enrolled in either: the third or fourth year of an accredited BSN program in the U.S., OR an accelerated program leading to a BSN degree (RN-to-BSN or BA-to-BSN), OR an accelerated master's entry program in nursing for students with bachelor's degrees in fields other than nursing; minimum 3.0 GPA required.
