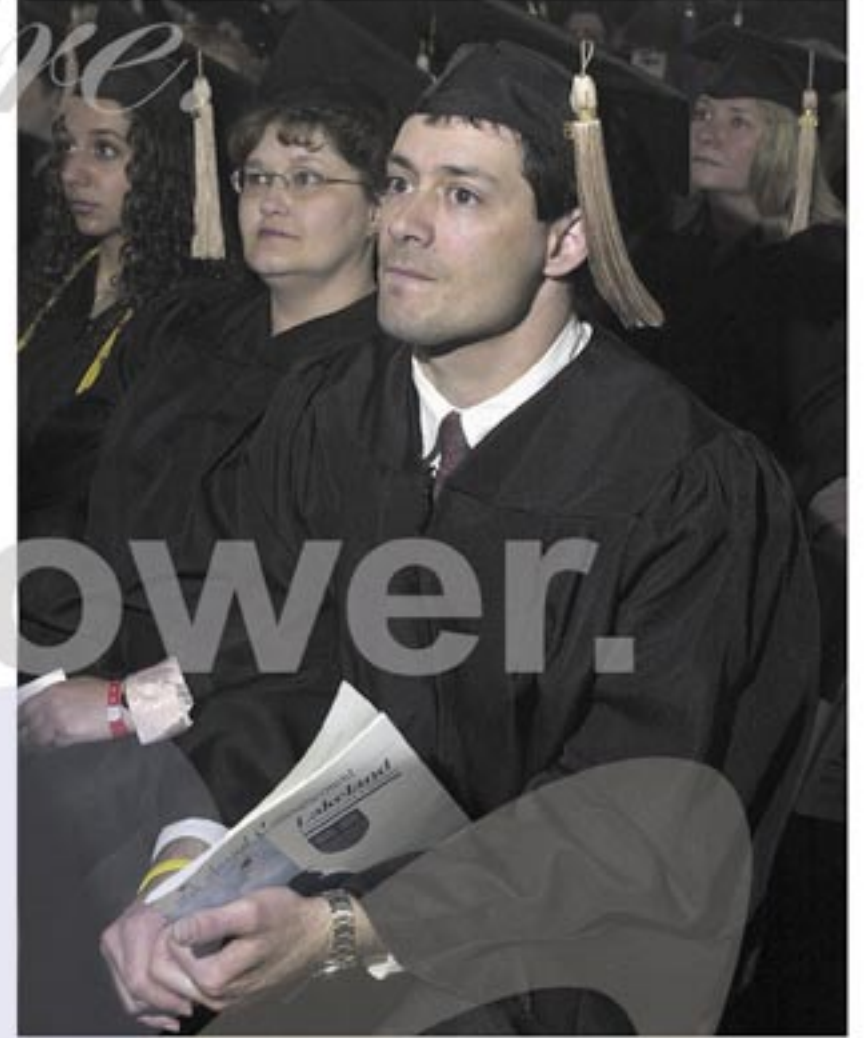

We thank you for your past support and hope you will continue your investment in the Lakeland Foundation and its efforts to make a difference in the lives of Lakeland students.

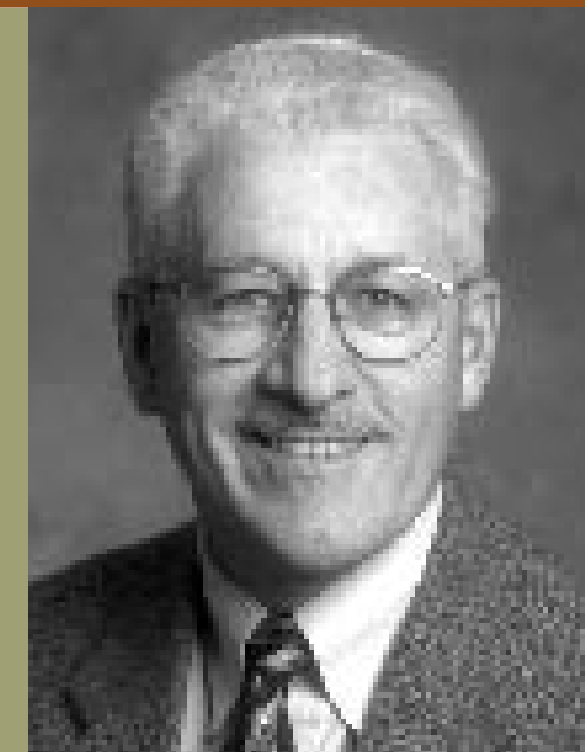
## A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

I look forward to remaining on the Lakeland Foundation Board and continuing to contribute to our success for many years to come.

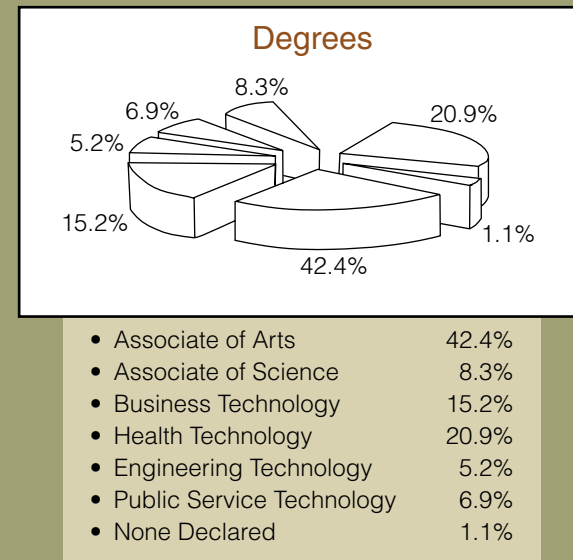
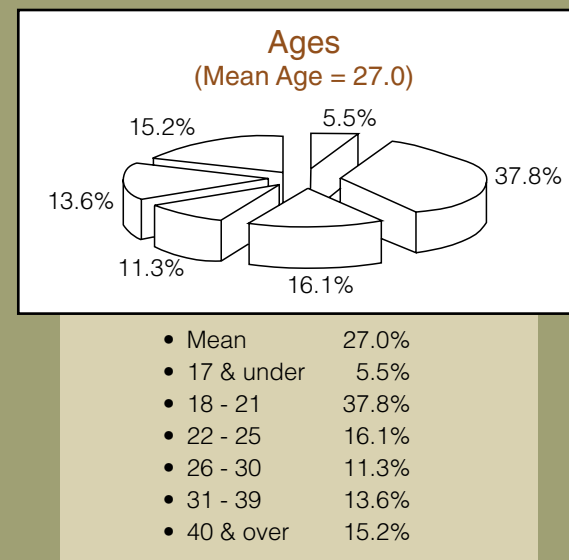
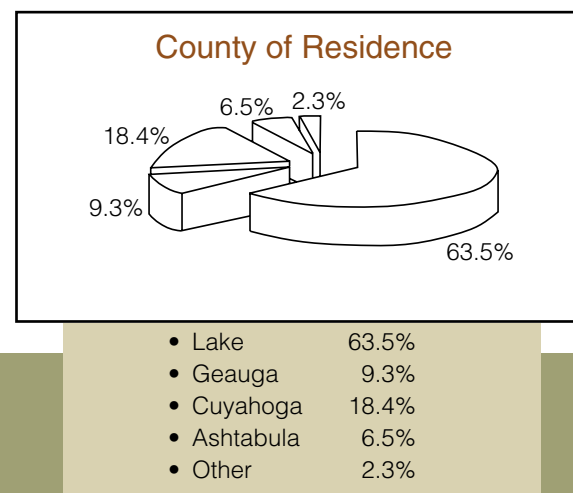
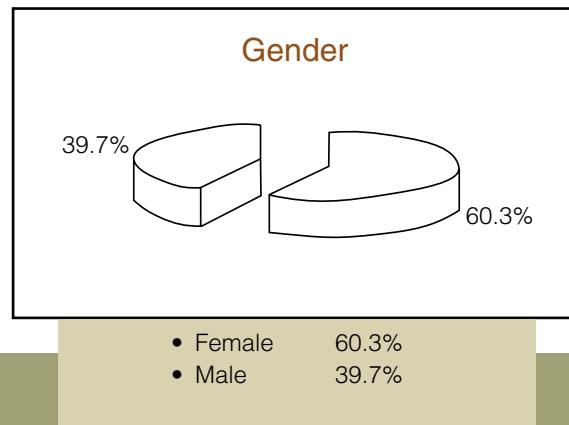
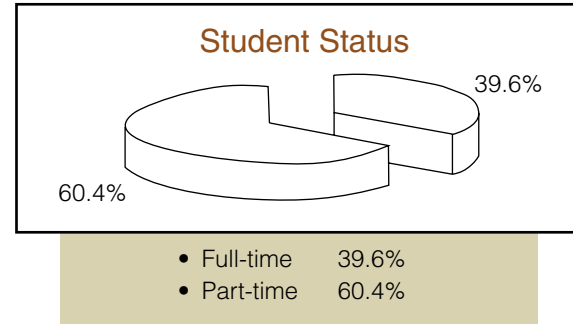
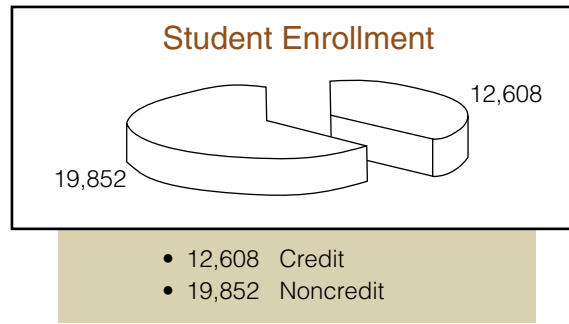

## HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PERIOD

The Lakeland Foundation Board committees developed and implemented action plans to support the goals of the Strategic Plan. *The committees include: Board Relations, Investment, Scholarship/Mastin, Project Review, Annual Giving, Major Gifts and Planned Giving.*

A Planned Giving Seminar was hosted by The Lakeland Foundation and sponsored by *Fifth Third Bank Investment Advisors, the Lakeland Foundation, Huntington National Bank, Mellon and the Cleveland Foundation* on November 17, 2004. This highly successful seminar was designed for attorneys, financial planners, CPA's, CFP's and insurance agents. The Foundation hosted a reception following the seminar.

Four community leaders joined the Board as new Directors - **Dennis Eckart, Adelbert "Chip" Marous, and Jerome T. Osborne, III and Ka-Pi Hoh.** (see Board roster on Page 15 for details).

In 2004, a total of 801 students received scholarships, grants and loans equaling \$391,524.

In 2004-2005, Technology Access Grants in the amount of \$30,344.64 were given to support technology needs of 64 students.

Funding was approved to support ten faculty challenge grants including: OATYC Conference, Attendance at Hospice & Palliative Care Study Seminar, Introducing Robotics to Technology Students, Construction of two In-Lab Aquariums, Research in Los Angeles to complete and publish a book about the movie Psycho, Enhancement of Second Annual Comics Symposium, Attendance at Radiological Society of North America (RSNA), Grad Intern, Poetry Contest and Teaching Information.

*William A. Armstrong*, Associate Professor, Mathematics, and *Patrick McLaughlin*, Assistant Professor, English were awarded the Excellence in Teaching Awards, sponsored by the Foundation.

Seven projects in the area of sciences and the environment for children were financially supported through the Mastin Fund: *DNA Fingerprinting, Small Fry Science, College for Kids, Mentor Marsh Field Trips, College for Teens, Summer Youth Programs, and SEMAA.*

Donor Scholar Breakfast was held on April 7, 2005 and provided opportunities for scholarship students to meet many of the generous donors who made their education possible.

Alumni joined together for the annual Clocktower Run/Walk in October. The Clocktower Run was held on October 3, 2004 with 135 participants and proceeds benefiting the Olga Freitag Scholarship Fund.

The Investment Committee continued to work with Mellon Private Wealth Management, the Foundation's investment manager, to oversee the investment of our donors. The improved economic trend provides a positive outlook for our assets (see Financial Highlights).

The Campaign for the Future of Lakeland began July 1, 2004. **Michael Minnaugh** and **Dennis Eckart** are campaign co-chairs. **Arthur and Arlene Holden** and **Congressman Steven LaTourette** are honorary campaign co-chairs.

The new Donor Wall was installed in the Performing Arts Center in June 2005.

The Lakeland Foundation held the Let's do Lunch, Jim Collins Luncheon Event on June 16, 2005. Jim Collins joined the Foundation as the first Executive-in-Residence.

The Lakeland Foundation sponsored a second annual Signature Event on October 1, 2004. The *Puttin' on the Ritz* benefit at Mooreland was a wonderful success in many ways—creating awareness, having fun, and raising money to support our students.

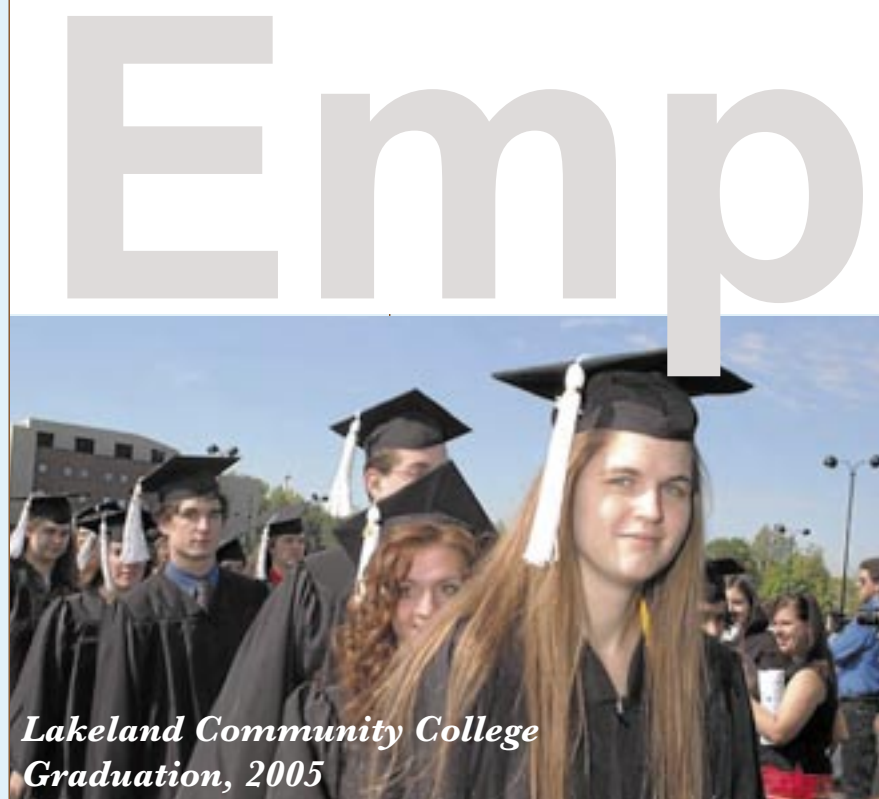
