



Library Friday and Saturday Survey Results

Library staff have been asking all library users on Fridays and Saturdays to complete a survey that tells us who they are (student or not) and what they are using in the library. Of the 313 surveys completed so far, 246 were Lakeland students and 29 were students from other colleges. The remaining were alumni, community users and faculty. The majority have been in to use the Internet, closely followed by copier use and quiet study.

It Takes a Village Idiot, by Jim Mullen.

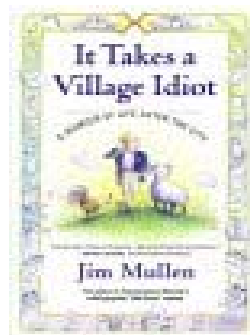
The discussion will take place on Wednesday, July 22 at noon in the library workroom: C-2058.
