Human Traces: A Novel by Sebastian Faulks

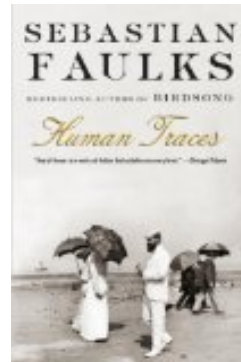
The discussion will take place on Tuesday, June 23 at noon in the library workroom: C-2058.

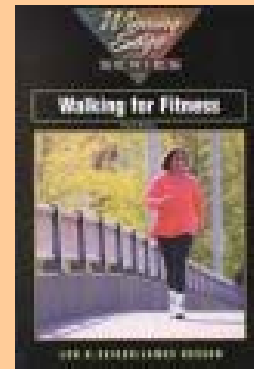


## June Library Display:
