
The library has assembled various tutorials to help students learn to use library resources on their own or as part of an online course. See the library's Database Demos page from the library homepage:

Some Database Demos are animated, some are self-paced, Power Point shows. Several of the tutorials were created by the database publishers.


Instructions for viewing the demos are included, as are links to any plug-ins required.

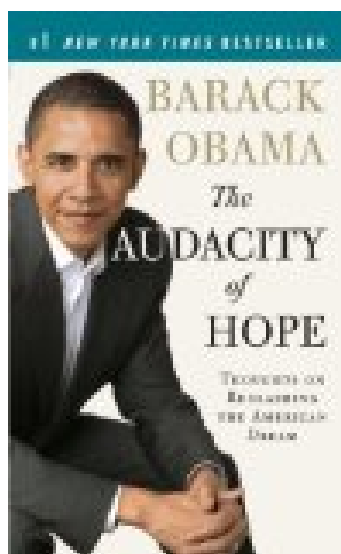
