

CCP Eligibility & Placement GUIDE

CCP Admissions Eligibility Requirements:

Students entering grades 10, 11, or 12 must meet one of the following:

High School GPA
3.0 or higher
(unweighted cumulative)

OR

ACT
English score of 18

OR

SAT
Evidence-Based Reading
& Writing score of 480

OR

Lakeland Accuplacer
Next-Generation Writing
Test score of 263

Students entering grades 7, 8, or 9 must submit qualifying test scores (see above) or take Lakeland's Accuplacer to be admitted into the CCP program, regardless of GPA.

** Certain technical certificate programs may have a different GPA requirement.*

Lakeland Accuplacer Next-Generation Writing Test:

What is it:

- The Accuplacer is a **free placement test** developed by the College Board.
- It uses **adaptive technology**, meaning each question adjusts based on your previous answers.
- All questions are **multiple-choice**.
- The test is **not timed**.
- It is administered on **Lakeland's campus**.

How to Schedule the Test:

- Complete the Lakeland CCP Application before scheduling for the test: www.lakelandcc.edu/apply
- After applying, schedule your test here: www.lakelandcc.edu/web/about/schedule-test-ccp
- Bring a photo ID on test day.
- Students are allowed three attempts per semester to meet the CCP eligibility requirements (excluding Summer).

Students who utilize test prep resources improve their scores by on average 8 points on the writing test and 10 points on the math test!

Math Placement:

- CCP students must meet the CCP admissions eligibility requirements (see reverse side of this handout) to enroll in any CCP course.
