

CCP Billing!

When the student owes the high school:

The High School bills for the below grades –

- AW – Administrative Withdraw ccp
- W – Withdraw
- F – Fail
- FNA – Failure for non-attendance

The High School uses the below CCP Cost Chart when billing students –

- CCP Cost Chart for 2026-27 Academic Year

The High School bills students after grades are posted for the semester.

- If the student is identified as being economically disadvantaged, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 3333-1-65.6(B)(2), the school district may not seek reimbursement.

When the student owes Lakeland:

Lakeland bills students for –

- MATH 0950 – Remedial Course Equivalent to Algebra 2* (*please refer to website for more details*)
- PEHR – One Credit Hour Activity Courses
- MUSC – Private Lesson Music Courses
- Students That Go Over Their Allowed 30 Credits for the Academic Year

Lakeland bills students based on Lakeland's standard rate of tuition –

- Lakeland's tuition chart is available on Lakeland's website. Under the "Admissions" tab, click on "Tuition & Fees."
 - **Books are \$25.00 per credit hour*

Lakeland bills students –

- Students that go over their allowed credits will receive a text message when their bill is ready to be paid. This typically happens in February/March of the Spring semester that they go over. Students will be billed for the entire course. Lakeland cannot split a payment for a course.
- MATH 0950, private lesson courses, and activity courses are charged to the student prior to the start of the semester.
