Algebra II Requirement & MATH 0950

The Ohio Department of Higher Education has a graduation crosswalk that outlines CCP course substitutes for high school graduation requirements.

The crosswalk states that students must earn 4 units of mathematics, including one unit of Algebra II or equivalent of Algebra II. Any college-level (nonremedial) course will be considered the equivalent of Algebra II.

To sum up this statement MATH 0950 is a remedial math class and that class alone will not fulfill the high school Algebra II graduation requirement.

Students must complete one full unit of Algebra II or an approved equivalent to meet high school graduation requirements.

Any college level non-remedial math course, for example MATH 1330, MATH 1550, MATH 1600 or MATH 1650 will be accepted as the equivalent of Algebra II.

If a student takes the following classes:

Algebra I
Geometry
MATH 0950
MATH 1330, 1550, 1600 or 1650

They will have completed 4 units of mathematics including one unit of Algebra II or equivalent.

If a student takes the following classes:

Algebra I
Geometry
MATH 0950
High School Statistics or Pre-Calculus

They will have completed 4 units of mathematics but do not have one unit of Algebra II or equivalent.
