The following are highlights and a summary of actions taken at the College Board of Trustees meeting on March 5, 2026:

- Mr. Paul Rupert, Board Chair, noted the following reminders for Board members: Spring Commencement on May 9, 2026; 2025 Financial Disclosure Statement due by May 15, 2026; and the ODHE Trustees Conference on September 10, 2026. He also noted the Showcase Award for the E-Building given to the College by the Willoughby Western Lake County Chamber of Commerce. Finally, he recognized Mr. David Cummins for his upcoming retirement and updated the Board on the search for David's replacement.
- The Board approved a resolution recognizing Professor Phil Roskos, Professor of Chemistry, for his long-standing service to the College and a plaque recognizing his contributions to the College to be located outside the Organic Chemistry Laboratory on campus; a resolution for renewal of the Cardinal Community Credit Union campus branch agreement; and a resolution to adjust rates of tuition commencing summer semester 2026.
- The Board received an update on the FY27 budget development, Spring 2026 enrollment data from the Ohio Association of Community Colleges, and enrollment and fiscal data from the Ohio Department of Higher Education.
- The Board approved updates to the following policies (Policy 3354:2-03-08, Financial Records and Audits; Policy 3354:2-11-05, Identify Theft Prevention; Policy 3354:2-31-01, Treasury Management; and Policy 3354:2-39-01, Solicitation and Sales Policy) and received the Personnel Report.
- Finally, the Board received a review of the Financial Report for the period ending January 31, 2026; updates regarding Experience Lakeland Day, the Northeast Ohio Science and Engineering Fair, and the All County Boards Breakfast; and highlights of faculty, staff, and student accomplishments.
