Acknowledgement

Lakeland Community College has signed and returned to the Department of Education (ED) the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) to provide emergency grant to students.

Total Funds

Lakeland Community College received \$1,536,947 in CRRSAA grant funds for students.

Total Distribution

As of July 7, 2021 Lakeland has awarded \$1,317,414 in CRRSAA grant funds to students.

Number of Students Who Have Received CRRSAA Funds

As of July 7, 2021, 1,673 students have been awarded CRRSAA grant funds.

Determination of Distribution

All students enrolled in spring 2021 with a Pell eligible EFC were awarded \$500 in CRRSAA grant funds. This met ED's requirement that CRRSAA funds be awarded with priority to students with exceptional need. Additionally, all enrolled students for summer 2021 who have an eligible expense due to the COVID-19 pandemic including, but not limited to, items related to their cost of attendance, such as tuition and fees, books, food, technology, transportation, medical and mental health care and child care may apply for a maximum of \$1500 in CRRSAA grant funding.
