

If you are a working adult who feels called to advocate for others in a meaningful way, the online bachelor's degree in social work may be for you. Complete your degree and prepare for licensure without quitting your current job. The program offers a collaborative, flexible, and challenging curriculum, and a sense of community in each class. Because the program is fully accredited by the Ohio Department of Higher Education and the Council on Social Work Education, graduates have the option of advanced placement in a master's degree program, having earned up to 15 credits of graduate-level work with the BSW program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Prospective students must meet the Ursuline College Accelerated Program (UCAP) admission standards for transfer students. These recommendations include a minimum of 30 previous college credits and a cumulative grade-point average (GPA) of 2.5. Students looking to transfer with less than 30 credit hours or lower than a 2.5 GPA can still apply and may qualify for conditional admission. We require the completion of an online application at <https://www.ursuline.edu/admission/overview> and the submission of all transcripts from previous colleges. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable, with official transcripts required within your first semester of classes.

PARALLEL PROGRAM:

A completed Associate of Arts or Associate of Applied Science degree is highly recommended, but not required.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE:

Once the online application and all previous college transcripts are received, the applicant will be evaluated for acceptance into the UCAP/ Holden University Partnership program. A follow-up meeting will be scheduled to review your degree plan, course options and if ready to move forward, proceed with course registration.
