ounded in 1967, Lakeland Community
College was the first college in Ohio
created by a vote of the people. True
to our mission, Lakeland provides
quality learning opportunities to meet the
social and economic needs of the community.
Likewise, Lakeland's Holden University Center
exemplifies the mission of the college both
by allowing area residents to conveniently
and affordably earn bachelor's and graduate
degrees, and by helping area businesses fill the
demand for qualified workers.

In 2010, the college made a levy promise to create a university center to satisfy the need for Lake County area residents to earn a 4-year degree close to home. The center would also add much needed classroom and laboratory

space for Lakeland students and expand training opportunities for local businesses. In the fall of 2011, the Holden University Center opened with seven college and university partnerships offering 14 programs to prospective students. Currently, there are 11 partners and more than 30 programs from which to choose.

Located on the main campus of Lakeland Community College, west of State Route 306, the Holden University Center provides an affordable, quality education and convenient way to earn a bachelor's or graduate degree close to home. By removing some of the barriers that have prevented area residents from getting their degrees and improving their lives, Lakeland's Holden University Center is transforming higher education in Lake County.

Students may take their first two to three years of coursework at Lakeland – at the lower community college tuition rate – and then transfer seamlessly into a university center partnership program. Graduates of the programs receive their degrees from the partner institutions.





Master of Social Work



Class Format.



Classes are taught by university partners through multiple delivery methods including:

Online Courses

In fully online courses all instruction is delivered online. Students are not required to come to campus to participate in any portion of the coursework or evaluation.

• On-site Courses

In on-site classes students are required to come to campus for class.

• Blended (Hybrid) Courses

The blended (hybrid) course provides the advantages of face-to-face interaction between faculty and students with the flexibility and convenience of less time in the classroom. Significant coursework and interactions between instructor, students and classmates take place both in the classroom and online.

• Interactive Video Distance Learning (IVDL)

IVDL classrooms combine the traditional face-to-face instruction with distance learning by using special video and audio conferencing technology to connect two or more classrooms. Students located in one classroom are able to interact in real-time with an instructor and students located at a distance.

Bookstore: Located on the first floor of A-Building, the Lakeland Bookstore is authorized to carry university partner textbooks if requested by a partnership faculty member. The bookstore also carries a large variety of school and office supplies as well as personal items.

Campus involvement opportunities: Lakeland offers art gallery exhibits, civic band, chorus, jazz, and orchestra concerts, and theater productions through Arts at Lakeland. Intramural sports and recreation, plus more than 30 student clubs and organizations are also offered.

Campus Kids: Lakeland Community College provides an on-site child care center for children of students who are enrolled in credit courses at the college or at the Holden University Center.

Career Services: Located on the first floor of A-Building, room A-1039, Lakeland's Career Services Center offers career information and employment-related services, including workshops for resume writing, interview skills and more.

Computer access: Computer labs, virtual desktops and laptops are available throughout the facility for student use. Be sure to visit the Holden University Center Navigation Desk for more information on locations and bring a photo ID for borrowing laptops.

Dining and vending: Snacks, beverages, and coffee machines are located on the first and second floors of the university center. Additional options for dining on campus are available in Breakers Dining Hall, BUZZ Cafe or other smaller facilities throughout Lakeland's campus.

Help Desk: Lakeland's Help Desk can assist with technical questions regarding wireless internet access, computer hardware or software, system problems, and more.

Lakeland Athletic & Fitness Center (AFC): The AFC is available to Holden University Center partnership students in the current semester at no charge, with a valid Lakeland ID.

Lakeland Library: Lakeland's Library is a full partner in the teaching and learning process of the college community. Resources and access are extended to partnership students.

Lakeland Testing and Writing Centers:

Partnership students are able to utilize both the writing center and proctoring services throughout their studies at the university center.

Parking and shuttle service: Parking is free and open to all faculty, staff, students and guests. The college, in partnership with Laketran, offers Laketran's Campus Loop (Route 7) with service every 10 minutes connecting points from the university center (U-Building) to the T-Building.

Printing & copying: Lakeland provides partnership students with \$10 in free printing and copying each semester.



Next Steps.

STEP 1

Enroll in a Lakeland associate degree program or transfer other college credits into a partnership program.

STEP 2

If necessary, take bridge courses at Lakeland Community College - at Lakeland's tuition rate - to further prepare for upper level division courses.
