

# **Preparing For Graduation Day**

# **Eligibility**

To be eligible to graduate and receive your diploma, you should have already completed and submitted an online <u>application for graduation</u> (myLakeland login required). You are eligible to participate in the May 2024 commencement ceremony if you have fulfilled your requirements as of the fall 2023 semester or will potentially complete requirements in either spring semester 2024 or summer term 2024. If you have any questions regarding eligibility, please contact the counseling and advising center at 440.525.7200. Please note that participation in the commencement ceremony does not constitute the completion of graduation requirements.

#### Academic Regalia

A cap, gown and tassel are the official regalia that you must wear at commencement. If you did not indicate on the graduation application that you wanted to purchase your regalia, you may still do so by returning to the graduation application and updating your selection. The regalia fee can be paid through your myLakeland account or at the cashier's office. Regalia is available for pick up in the Lakeland Bookstore. Check the <u>bookstore</u> <u>webpage</u> for current hours of operation.

#### **Commencement Honors**

If you attain a grade-point average (GPA) of 3.50 or higher through your last fully completed and graded semester, you may be eligible to wear a gold honors cord at the ceremony. If you are eligible, the honors cord will be available to purchase with your regalia package.

#### **Guest Tickets**

You are entitled to receive up to six (6) guest tickets for the ceremony. Request your guest tickets in the <u>Graduation Application</u> (myLakeland login required). Guest tickets are free and are required for admission. Fire Marshal regulations require that all guests, including children of any age, have a ticket. Additional tickets can be requested through the Graduation Application. If tickets are available, you will be contacted by May 1, 2024, via your Lakeland student email. Tickets will be allocated in the order the request was received.

Pick up your tickets with your academic regalia in the Lakeland Bookstore. Check the <u>bookstore webpage</u> for current hours of operation.

#### **Commencement Photographer**

GradImages® is the official photographer for commencement. At the ceremony, a photo of you will be taken as you shake hands with a college official before exiting the stage. Please register online with GradImages to receive complimentary proofs shortly after commencement. You will also receive a discount offer just for pre-registering. ## Holden University Center Partnership Program Graduates

Candidates for graduation from the Holden University Center Partnership Programs are invited to participate in Lakeland Community College's 57th Annual Commencement Ceremony Saturday, May 11, 2024, at 2 p.m.

All Holden University Center candidates for graduation are to report to the Dr. Wayne L. Rodehorst Performing Arts Center in D-Building no later than 12:30 p.m. for complete instructions and to line up for the academic procession. Holden University Center Partnership Program candidates will be the last group of students in the procession. As a means of special recognition, Holden University Center Partnership Program candidates will be the final group to walk across the stage to receive a congratulatory certificate. Diplomas will be issued at a later date by the degree-granting institution. For more information, candidates should contact the registrar's office at their home institution.

Holden University Center candidates are entitled to receive up to six guest tickets. Guest tickets can be picked up at the Holden University Center Partnership Program office located on Lakeland's main campus on the ground floor of the H-Building, room H-074 (photo I.D. required). Tickets may also be mailed to participating partnership program graduates upon request. An RSVP is required for participation. # **On Graduation Day**

## Proper Attire Under Regalia

Commencement is a formal academic ceremony, so it is suggested that you wear comfortable business attire. Please do not wear sneakers, flip-flops, T-shirts, shorts or jeans.

#### Parking and Shuttle Service

Parking is free. Follow orders of police officers who will be directing traffic. Directional signs will be posted on campus designating handicapped parking areas. Free shuttle bus service will be available to transport guests to and from the parking lots. Shuttle buses will be operating from approximately 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

#### **Assembly of Graduates**

As a candidate for graduation, please report to the Dr. Wayne L. Rodehorst Performing Arts Center in the D-Building one- and one-half-hour before your ceremony:

- 10 a.m. ceremony arrive no later than 8:30 a.m. Saturday, May 11.
- 2 p.m. ceremony arrive no later than 12:30 p.m. Saturday, May 11.

Arrive dressed in your cap and gown. You will receive complete instructions regarding participation in the ceremony at this time; there is no dress rehearsal. The processional starts promptly 15 minutes before your ceremony:

- 10 a.m. ceremony processional starts promptly at 9:45 a.m.
- 2 p.m. ceremony processional starts promptly at 1:45 p.m.

You are not permitted to carry anything in your hands during the procession. A secured room will be provided for you to store any personal belongings for the duration of the ceremony.

## **Guest Seating**

Doors open one hour before your ceremony. Guests should arrive and take their seats promptly. Guests arriving late may be redirected to view commencement from an alternative location so as not to disrupt the ceremony in progress. Seating is limited and guests are required to present a ticket for admittance. Tickets will be collected. All guest seating is on bleachers. Guests requiring assistance or handicapped seating must have a handicapped ticket and will need to contact the Dean of Students via email at mpetitti@lakelandcc.edu or by phone at 440.525.7328 no later than Friday, May 3, to make arrangements.

## **Diploma Distribution**

During the commencement ceremony, a blank diploma cover will be presented to you. Your diploma, commemorative commencement program and letter of congratulations can be picked up in the Student Service Center on the first floor of the A-building. Fall 2023 diplomas are available now. Spring 2024 diplomas will be available for pick up approximately six weeks after the end of spring semester. Summer 2024 diplomas can be picked up approximately six weeks after the end of the summer term. Additional fees may apply for more than one degree, concentration, or certificate as well as any changes, including completion date, reprints or duplicates. #### **Financial Obligations**
