The following are highlights and a summary of actions taken at the College Board of Trustees meeting on April 23, 2026:

- Mr. Paul Rupert, Board Chair, noted the following reminders for Board members: Spring Commencement on May 9, 2026; 2025 Financial Disclosure Statement due by May 15, 2026; the Student Leader Awards Banquet on April 23, 2026; and the Ohio University signing event on May 13, 2026. He also acknowledged the Donor-Scholar Breakfast held on April 21, 2026.
- The Board approved the following resolutions (Resolution A11-26, Adopting a Policy for Curriculum Approval by the Board of Trustees; Resolution A12-26, Creating an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Information Technology; Resolution F12-26, Authorizing the Demolition of the T-Building, and Resolution F13-26, Adjusting Special Purpose Fees Commencing Summer Semester 2027) and the 2027-2028 Academic Calendar.
- The Board approved updates to the following policies (Policy 3354:2-47-01, Grading Policy; Policy 3354:2-36-01, Allowable Costs Associated with Travel, Meeting, and Other Amenities; Policy 3354:2-36-02, Acceptable Use of College Credit Cards and Cell Phones; Policy 3354:2-40-01, Post-Issuance Tax-Exempt Debt Compliance Policy; Policy 3354:2-03-01, Organization of the Board; and Policy 3354:2-20-03, Personnel Reports to the Board) and adopted a new policy on Curriculum Approval (3354:2-44-01).
- The Board approved a motion to engage BHDP for land use planning services and a motion to engage in the employment of Dr. Steven Hardy as the new Vice President for Administrative Services and Treasurer at the College.
- Finally, the Board received a review of the Financial Report for the Third Quarter ending March 31, 2026; updates on the FY27 budget development and Summer and Fall 2026 enrollment; and highlights of faculty, staff, and student accomplishments.
